MINUTES MOUNT VERNON PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION February 13, 2019

He is not currently able to get a traditional loan on the home and if he were to have any type of damages, the property would be restricted when trying to re-build and, the property is in a Traditional Residential neighborhood. The public hearing was closed after moved by Willems. Willems then made a motion to re-zone the property at 200 7th Street SE from commercial to Traditional Residential. Seconded by Elliott. Motion carried.
