## COLE LIBRARY BOARD OF TRUSTEES MINUTES JUNE 15, 2021

PRESENT: Cathy Boggs, Greg Cotton, Deb George, Diana Corcoran, Gwen Schimek-Tischler, Bob Meeker.

- I. The meeting was called to order by President Deb George at 8:36 a.m. in Room 108.
- II. The minutes were approved.
- III. REPORTS:
  - A. PRESIDENT: Thank you to the retiring board members; Deb George and Bob Meeker.
  - B. PUBLIC LIBRARY DIRECTOR:
    - 1. Summer Reading Program. Summer Reading is going very well with 104 children in the program. Also, there is a "Tweens" reading program and we have 52 in the Kids Club. Everyone has a Summer Reading T-shirt and all will receive a paint set from the Cole Library.
    - 2. Grant Request. The State of Iowa is offering grants through the federal government. The grants are to help pay for the changes libraries made during Covid-19. We will apply for the \$5,000 grant to use for;
      - a. cushions for Story Time
      - b. Hoopla
      - c. a Bridges supplement which allows Cole Library to access books specific to the demands of our library (only Mt. Vernon residents can use that book).
  - C. LIBRARIAN:
    - 1. We reviewed the financial report. Current available funds are \$17,000.
    - 2. Our available funds are higher than expected in part because:
      - a. the library did not have any programming costs during Covid.
      - b. the county funding was about \$4,000 more than anticipated.
      - c. a door repair bill was several thousand dollars under budget.
- IV. MAJOR BUSINESS:
  - 1. Hoopla. This is an instant digital access service for patrons. We will fund it using money from the State grant and our available funds. There will be a five items per month restriction on this service. This restriction can be adjusted later dependent on usage.
  - 2. Community Survey.
    - The final draft will be approved at the August board meeting and it will be submitted by September 2nd. The information from the survey is used to prepare our 5-year goals and plans.
  - 3. New Board Members. Names for potential board members were suggested.
  - 4. Thanks again to retiring board members Deb George and Bob Meeker.

The next board meeting is scheduled for August 24th, 8:30 a.m. in Room 108. The meeting was adjourned at 10:06 a.m.
