COLE LIBRARY BOARD OF TRUSTEES MINUTES SEPTEMBER 22, 2020

PRESENT: Cathy Boggs, Greg Cotton, Deb George, Tracey Louwagie, Diana Corcoran, Bob Meeker.

- I. The meeting was called to order by President Deb George at 8:31, via Zoom.
- II. The minutes were approved.

III. REPORTS:

- A. PRESIDENT: Election of Officers for next term.
 - President: Deb George Vice President: Tracey Louwagie Secretary: Bob Meeker Diana Corcoran will assume the role of President for the 2021 term when Deb George retires from the board.
- B. PUBLIC LIBRARIAN:
 - 1. End of the Year Report- Cathy will present the End of the Year Report to the City Council at the October City Council meeting.
 - 2. The Library is in operation daily, although the public is not yet allowed inside the building. The library continues to service the public with call in curbside pick-up and book bundles. The decision of when to open the doors of the Library will depend on seriousness of the pandemic.
 - 3. The Lester Buresh Center now has its own program of providing books for its members. The Center has its own library card and checks out age-related books from the Cole Library for use by the members of the Center.
 - 4. In coordination with the Lisbon Library, the Cole Library is planning a "Drive-In" Eulenspiegel Puppet Show. The cost to the Library will be about \$200.
- C. LIBRARIAN:
 - 1. The End of the Year Budget will be finalized in October. We had about \$2,000 higher income than expected.

IV. MAJOR BUSINESS:

- 1. The board will review the Collection Development Policy at the October meeting.
- 2. Community Survey: We have until 2023 to complete the Community Survey. We can delay action on the survey until next fall, 2021.
- 3. We have to make sure our board meetings comply with the "Open Meeting" law when the board meets on line with Zoom.
- 4. Budget requests from the City of Mount Vernon.

Librarian Greg Cotton is suggesting a five year budget request plan with yearly incremental increases of approximately \$13,00 per year. This plan is built on comparisons of costs per capita of other Type D libraries in the area. The average cost per capita for area libraries is currently \$47 per person. Greg's plan will move the Mont Vernon Public Library's budget requests from the city to that \$47 per capita level over the next five years.

The next meeting of the Board will be October 21, at 8:30 a.m. The meeting was adjourned at 9:54 a.m.
