 - Total circulation up 5% 23, 569 items circulated

B. FY27 Budget

- Asking for City to approve 4.2% increase for next year for salaries and benefits, increase of \$4,965 for the year
- Budget has to at least cover salaries so as not to affect programming, etc.
- Student workers are not being paid any different, so they remain the same until Cornell makes those changes.
- Overspent in acquisitions, advertising, and salary and benefits (because of added position) in 2025
- Copy and printing, supplies, and special projects expenses went down so lowering budget for them.
- Goal is to get more money for another position to be added ultimately upon Cathy's retirement, so Grace will bring this up to Chris at the City.
- Grace will present at the next meeting based on the information she receives.
